Road Tests Returning to Pre-Pandemic Locations

Road Tests will return to the following RMV Service Centers beginning the week of June 21, 2022. Tests have not been available here since before the pandemic.

- Easthampton (Class D only) - Tuesdays and Wednesdays
- Martha's Vineyard (Class D and M) - Tuesdays only
- Southbridge (Class D only) - Thursdays and Fridays
- South Yarmouth (Class D and M) - Wednesdays and Thursdays

Road tests at these locations can be scheduled through [Mass.Gov/RMV](https://www.mass.gov/rmv) or through the Contact Center.

All road test applicants are required to bring their own vehicle for their Class D or Class M road tests that meets our safety and equipment requirements. Class D vehicles must have an emergency brake in the center console of the vehicle that is accessible to the examiner. Applicants can visit [Mass.Gov/RoadTest](https://www.mass.gov/roadtest) to get familiar with vehicle and sponsor requirements.
